## Community Bulletin Civic Affairs Committee

<u>City Candidates Forum at NH:</u> The NH Civic Affairs Committee will sponsor a forum for the June 3<sup>rd</sup> Torrance city election candidates. This forum is only for NH residents due to space limitations.

**Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup>** – Treasurer, City Clerk, and Mayoral candidates

**Sunday, May 4<sup>th</sup>** – City Council (there are 16) candidates

Level 1 Water Supply Shortage: The City Council unanimously voted to authorize the activation of Level 1 Water Supply Shortage Condition. It prohibits outdoor watering from 9 am to 5 pm, limits outdoor watering to 3 days a week and requires that all leaks be repaired within 7 days. This early water conservation measure will help maintain our current reserved water supply. Torrance residents decreased their water consumption by 17% when Level 1 was implemented in 2009.

Meals on Wheels provides nutritious home delivered meals for the housebound. Each delivery consists of two meals, one hot meal to be eaten at midday and a cold meal for the evening. A milk and a juice pack are also included with every delivery. Meals are planned by a registered dietician and are nutritionally balanced to include each of the four main food groups. Special diets for specific medical conditions can usually be accommodated. The meals are delivered between 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., 5 days a week, Monday through Friday except on holidays. The charge for this service is \$6.00 per day.

It takes a village! We call them "Angels" - over 200 volunteers provide this service. They travel in teams of two, and not only deliver the food, but also check on the well-being of each client. For many clients, Meals on Wheels allows the clients to live at home, independently and with dignity.

If you know a neighbor, friend, or family member of any age or income, who is unable to leave their home because of injury, poor health or disability, please refer them to us. We are here to serve.



Reminder: the Conservation Club continues its **pickup the first Friday of the month**, which includes CRV containers, aluminum cans, beer bottles. **No newspapers**. Suggestions are welcomed.

## Do recycle: (in the bins provided)

Newspapers, cardboard, packaging, phone books. Plastic bottles, bags, dairy tubs, pill containers Metal cans, aluminum, steel, tin foil and trays Glass bottles and jars

### Do not recycle:

Food or soiled materials
Clothing, textiles, shoes
Batteries, lightbulbs, aerosol cans
Styrofoam containers, packing materials

## DISASTER PREPAREDNESS - GET READY !!!

La Habra and Chile recently had earthquakes!! Are we ready for a powerful earthquake?

At New Horizons we have a Disaster Preparedness Plan with a Communication Center, Area Directors, Building Coordinators, Search and Rescue teams, First Aid Station.

How About You? Are you prepared to stay alive for five or more days in the event of a major disaster? Our Disaster Management Team requests that you have on hand the following supplies in your condo, car, or garage.

- 1. Water one gallon per person per day
- 2. Food ready to eat or canned
- 3. Manual can opener
- 4. First Aid Kit

#### 5. Essential medications!!!

- 6. Flashlight and Radio battery operated
- 7. Cash in small denominations
- 8. Unscented liquid bleach for water purification
- 9. Set of clothes, shoes, socks, underwear, in a "Go" bag
- 10. Personal hygiene items toilet paper, tooth paste/brush, etc
- 11. Heavy gloves and plastic gloves
- 12. Fire extinguisher know how to use
- 13. Water and electricity: need to know how to shut off
- 14. Blanket, towel and/or sleeping bag
- 15. Pet water and supplies
- 16. Important documents copies in waterproof envelope, bag, or disc/drive
- 17. Have tennis shoes, socks, helmet, heavy gloves and flashlight under your bed or nearby.

OCTOBER IS OUR PRACTICE DRILL FOR EARTHQUAKE PREPAREDNESS. Our Disaster Management Team will meet every other month to finalize our procedure. All members plus BUILD-ING COORDINATORS for each building are invited to come to our meetings this year to get ready for our OCTOBER DRILL. Our next meetings are on third Thursdays of alternate months, May 15<sup>th</sup>, July 17<sup>th</sup>, and September 18<sup>th</sup>. ALL BUILDING COORDINATORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND THESE MEETINGS.
