MINUTES OF THE ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE MEETING SEPTEMBER 17, 2013

Chairman Gary Smith called the meeting to order at 9:30am. Present were Carl Aleccia, Kathy Lindbergh, Bill Parker, and Eileen Rivet. Guests were Paul Cohen and Tom Kasterko.

The minutes from the August meeting were approved as written.

MONTHLY REPORTS

Painting on Bldg. 414 was completed on 9/10/13. Extra time and labor was required because the building was in very poor shape. Bldg. 415 was started on 9/16/2013 and should be completed by 10/11/2013.

In the three days allotted for touchups, 7 work requests were completed. Six requests are still pending. 2 require action by owners before work can be completed. 2 new requests have been received.

OPEN DISCUSSIONS

GET READY FOR EARTHQUAKE PREPAR-EDNESS AT NEW HORIZONS

We have a Disaster Preparedness plan at New Horizons with a Communication Center, Area Directors, and Building Coordinators for follow-up after a major earthquake. This includes a First Aid Station, Search and Rescue Teams, and check of buildings and grounds after an earthquake.

"How About You?" Are you prepared to stay alive for five days or more in the event of a major disaster? Our Disaster Management Team requests that you have on hand the following supplies:

- Water, one gallon per person per day
- Food canned or ready to eat
- Manual can opener
- First Aid Kit
- Essential medications
- Flashlight & Radio
- Unscented liquid bleach for water purification
- Set of clothes, socks, shoes, underwear
- Personal hygiene items toilet paper, tooth paste/brush, etc.
- Heavy gloves and plastic gloves
- Have and know how to use your ABC fire extinguisher
- Know location of your water and electric shut offs
- Blanket, towel and/or sleeping bag
- Pet supplies and water for pets
- Cash in small denominations
- Important documents on flash drive/copies in water proof bag/folder



Ach Du Lieber! On Saturday, October 19, we are going to Oktoberfest! We will be observing this German tradition among the pines at Big Bear Lake. This is Big Bear's 43rd annual festival, making it one of Southern California's favorite Oktoberfests. We are sure to have a full German luncheon with all the traditional favorites (beer of course, bratwurst, chicken and sauerkraut.) There will also be a band direct from Germany and a guided tour around Big Bear Lake with a costumed host. You will have to get up early for this trip. We leave at 7:30am and return at 6:00pm. It will be a full day, but a good one. The cost for this "wunderbar" experience including deluxe round trip coach transportation, the trip around the lake and the festival with all the umpah fun (Chicken Dance anyone) will be \$70.00. 






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
