## What Does Go Into the Black Recycle Container?



It has been brought to my attention that some residents are still not certain what the Conservation Club recycles. Here are the items we collect:

Plastic water bottles (all sizes)

CRV plastic **beverage** bottles (must say CRV on the bottle)

Aluminum beverage cans

Glass beer bottles (all colors)

Glass beverage bottles (Snapple, ice tea, etc)

Sports drinks (Gatorade, PowerAde, etc.)

Plastic & glass fruit & vegetable juice bottles

For your convenience we have 11 black recycle containers (pictured) located inside designated trash enclosures. Residents may still continue to store their recyclable items in their unit and set them out on our 1<sup>st</sup> of the month recyclable Friday pick-up. Please set them out by 9:00 AM on pick-up day.

The following are items we do NOT recycle:

NO NEWSPAPER

NO MILK PRODUCTS

NO PLASTIC FOOD CONTAINERS

NO CARDBOARD

NO ALUMINUM FOOD CONTAINERS

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 16<sup>TH</sup> AT 10 AM IN THE MORNING WILL BE OUR DISASTER PREPAREDNESS PRACTICE DRILL AT NEW HORIZONS - WE NEED ALL OF YOU TO GET READY!

Our **Disaster Preparedness Plan** for New Horizons has a Communication Center, Area Directors and Building Coordinators, Search and Rescue Teams, TARA volunteers, a First Aid Station and Grounds check ready in case of a major earthquake.

We will use the Clubhouse on the grass area near the Golf course as our headquarters for this drill. All emergency services and Disaster Team members will operate from there.

When a sudden emergency happens (earthquake), all residents are to follow these procedures:

1. Take care of yourself first. Duck, cover and hold on until the shaking stops!
2. Get to your disaster materials and take out your flashlight (if it is night). Put on your tennis shoes, helmet, and turn off water and electrical panel, if necessary.
3. Place your "HELP" or "OK" SIGN on the outside of your door, wall, or window.
4. If you have a fire extinguisher, place it outside your unit.
5. Check with your Building Coordinator and Area Director for further directions and/or instructions.

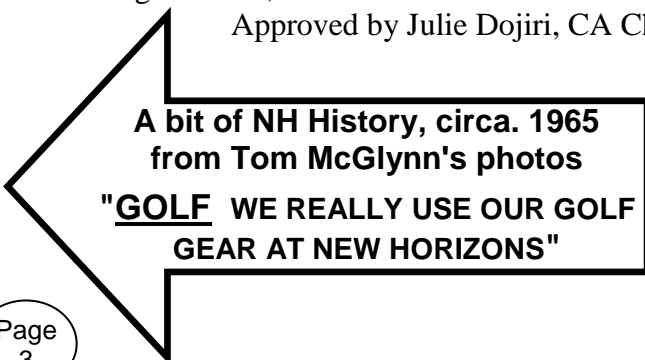
Small things we can do is to participate in Civic Affairs Committee's Outreach Program. These include the following:

1. Collect outdated **prescription glasses** which are delivered to Kaiser Permanente. They are renovated and sent to those in need.
2. Our new collection item is outdated **hearing aids** to Miracle-Ear, Redondo Beach, for renovation. These also find their way to those in need.
3. A collection is made of "**Labels for Education.**" Labels are on various soup cans, food boxes, paper goods etc. See Club House bulletin board "Civic Affairs" for samples of these labels. (Note: Labels come in different colors and sizes.) These are given to Hickory Elementary School. Labels allow the school to purchase educational items that are needed, but not supplied by the District.
4. Last but not least is the collection of **tattered & faded US flags**. This keeps our own New Horizons flags flying proud and in honorable condition. These flags are donated to the Lomita Boy Scout Troop #388 for ceremonial retirement.

This article is coupled with Julie Dojiri's recycle article in this Newsletter issue. The entire trash program is the responsibility of the chair of Grounds Maintenance.

The HOA's trash company is Republic Trash Services. They pick up our regular trash on Monday and Thursday, also. Republic picks up recyclable in the white bins located in the accesses 1, 7, and 9 (Garage J).

Pick up schedule at access 1 is Monday and Thursday, access 7 and 9 on Mondays.

Recycle items in the White bins should be washed and clean where appropriate. Items to be picked up in the white recycle bins are: newspapers, milk products, plastic food containers, card board, aluminum food containers and magazines.
