**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE ROUNDUP**

The NH Conservation Club will sponsor the HHW/E-Waste Roundup on **Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup> and Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>.**

The collection site will be in Access 1, adjacent to the fence enclosure in front of the golf driving net on the south side of the Club House.

What is Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)? HHW is any product labeled **TOXIC, POISON, CORROSIVE, FLAMMABLE, COMBUSTABLE, OR IRRITANT.**

Why E-Waste (Electronics)? They are categorized hazardous waste because they contain a number of toxic components including lead, mercury and other heavy metals.

**Please package your HHW carefully.** All items should be tightly capped or taped down. Put small containers containing liquids into baggies. Medicines should be in the original container with personal information removed or blacked out. Pack fluorescent bulbs to avoid breakage.

A list of collectable items will be posted on the bulletin board in the Clubhouse.

Have you ever taken a "Mystery Trip"? That's where you show up at the bus, get on and let the bus take you to a totally unknown destination. Sound intriguing? It can be, especially for the adventurous souls. Well, that's what we have coming up this month. This should be a lot of fun. You sign up for the trip without knowing where you are going. But I can tell you it will be a thoroughly delightful experience and one you will talk about for a long time. The date is Thursday, June 27 and the cost is \$63.00. Included in this cost is the event itself, lunch at one of the oldest and best known restaurants in Southern California, and deluxe motor-coach transportation. If you have never been there, you might like to know that Pechanga is California's largest Casino and the beautiful, family-owned Wilson Winery features a wide selection of estate wines. This trip is scheduled for Thursday, July 18 and the cost is \$71.00. We will be signing up for this trip at our June Meeting. Won't you join us?

#### INDIVIDUAL WORK REQUESTS:

The men are currently working on 8 work requests.

#### SCHEDULED WORK:

The work on Bldg. 410 has been completed. The work started on 4/16/2013 and completed on 5/16/2013. The painting on Bldg. 311 should begin on /24/2013.

The men are able to use the spray equipment more often which helps expedite the painting. When Bldg. 411 is finished, the decision will be made as to whether to move to 412 or take some time and work on some garages in the area where the buildings are in need of painting.

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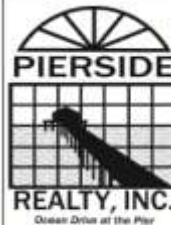
