

It's soup time!!!

Easy (and delicious!) Cabbage Soup



Ingredients:

Serves 8

3 tablespoons olive oil

1/2 onion, chopped

2 cloves garlic, chopped

1/2 head of cabbage, coarsely chopped

1 can (14.5 oz) Italian style diced tomatoes

2 quarts water

4 teaspoons chicken bouillon granules

1 teaspoon salt (optional)

1/2 teaspoon black pepper (optional)

A tablespoon or two of sour cream (regular or light-) - optional. Add when serving, just on top or stir it in if you like.

1. In a large stockpot, heat olive oil over medium heat. Stir in onion and garlic; cook until onion is transparent, about 5 minutes.
2. Stir in water, bouillon, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil, then stir in cabbage. Simmer until cabbage wilts, about 10 minutes.
3. Stir in tomatoes. Return to a boil, then simmer 15 to 30 minutes, stirring often.

Serve it with a warm, crusty bread. Yumm!
