Paul Getty Villa for lack of signups. So one of the first bits of business was to replace the Getty Villa trip with another. We regret we had to take this action for there were a modest number of you who really wanted to see this international educational center dedicated to the study of the arts and cultures of ancient Greece, Rome and Etruria. It truly is a fascinating attraction. Our replacement trip should appeal to our members who enjoy musical comedy theater (and who doesn't?). On Saturday, March 23, we will be going to the Glendale Center Theater to see the award winning show "Crazy for You." This riotously entertaining show is a romantic musical comedy filled with a number of George and Ira Gershwin's classic songs. Meeting called to order at 10:00am by Kathy Lindbergh, Chairman of Executive & Rules Committee.

Motions discussed below for wording and compliance with the Governing Documents.

#1 Motion presented by Joyce Harrington, Grounds Maintenance Chairman

Move that the New Horizons-South Bay Association Board of Directors approve the Amount of \$7,725.00 for the shaping, trimming, and cutting of the Olive Trees and (2) remaining Pine Trees. The preferred vendor is Finley's Tree & Landscape, Inc. The source of funding to come from the Grounds Maintenance Fund.

#2 Motion presented by Carl Aleccia, Buildings and Pools Chairman

Move that the New Horizons-South Bay Association Board of Directors approve the amount of \$16,500.00 for the plan preparation, and approval from the City of Torrance and to repair the existing retaining south wall of the Madrona Med Center, 3290 Sepulveda Blvd. Torrance, by removing damaged part of wall and rebuild it. Cause of damage to brick wall was a tree on New Horizons property which has been removed. Three (3) bids have been obtained. The preferred vendor is HMH Construction Group. Source of funding to come from the Building and Pools Maintenance Fund.

#3 Motion presented by Carl Aleccia, Building and Pools Chairman

Move that the New Horizons-South Bay Association Board of Directors approve the amount of 4,417.53 for the Emergency Service of Water Extraction and Remediation of a leak from a pipe in the wall in building 503, unit 23002 Nadine Circle, Torrance. This emergency service was performed Sunday evening, January 6, 2013. The vendor was Dry Down. Source of funding to come from the Building and Pools Maintenance Fund.

#4 Motion presented by Leon Silverman, Treasurer

Move that the New Horizons South Bay Association Board of Directors initiate a search for an in house office manager. The individual must be thorough and knowledgeable in accounting administration, contract and be able to assist our Fund Chairman as well as work jointly with our Executive Board.

#5 Emergency Motion presented by Carl Aleccia

Move that the New Horizons South Bay Association Board of Directors approve the expenditure of \$5,365.80 for termite tenting of building 307 on January 28, 2013.

This service was performed by preferred vendor Ever/Safe Exterminating Co., Inc. For the record, this building was not termited in August 2010. Source of funding to come from the Building and Pools Maintenance Fund.

Motions to be discussed at Board Workshop, Wed., February 13, 2013, and vote on Motions at Board Meeting, Wednesday, February 20, 2013.
