DEAR READERS OF THE PAPER EDITION.

We at the Newsletter staff, like other volunteers making other community efforts, try our best to reduce cost and waste while improving our services.

Late last year we conducted an intensive survey to find out how many of our residents wanted printed copies of the newsletter delivered to them, and how many would use our website instead. After 2 months of prominent announcements in each issue, **302** households did not request delivery to their doors. **This showed a potential saving of \$ 15,000/yr. by reducing printing and mailing costs.** Evidently, not all residents need or want paper delivery.

While at first our website was not very user friendly, now it is as easy to use as the average website. We even received comments on how good the paper looks on the web.

After talking with many readers about our website, we learned that **many of our readers don't customarily browse the web, but do use email** for keeping in touch. **So now we are offering to have the newsletter e-mailed to you**, so you get it along with messages from people you know. However, **if** you have your internet software security set to accept mail only from a pre-approved sender (like family-) you or someone you trust should add our e-mail address to the approved list.

Please do not call, but use the Newsletter Request form on page 4. Copies of the form will remain available at the N. H. office, so that you may, at any time, choose a delivery option.
